**Recommendation to Award the Removals, Logistics & Storage contract to Quicksilver
(PCC/467/2022)**

Summary

The current removals contract expired in 2020 but due to Covid it was agreed that we would continue with the incumbent provider during this period as changing while we needed them to carry out national collections of PPE and help us to store goods would have impacted on policing delivery.

As we returning to normality, this requirement has now been retendered, enabling us to test the market with our new requirements to ensure we were getting the best value for money.

Recommendation/Findings:


It is recommended that the contract is awarded to Quicksilver as they provided the most economically advantageous tender response.

Contract value is £450,000 and the proposed award is for a three-year contract, with the option to extend for a further two, twelve-month periods, with the extension being included to allow for a review of the contract at the end of the three-year period, to ensure the contract is still the best solution for our needs.
