Ethiopian Community in Newcastle	Funding to deliver diversionary activities to 30 young people aged 11-16 during the summer holidays who are vulnerable and marginalised, the majority being from refugee and asylum seeker families on very low income.	£4,674
Heart Remind Community Interest Company	Heart Remind, in partnership with NE Youth, currently deliver DJ and Graffiti Art sessions to NE Youth's Youth Session in Ponteland, and they seek continuation funding to continue this project in Ponteland, as well as opening up the sessions to the Throckley Youth Project in Throckley.	£3,134
Blue Button Café	Funding to offer free art and craft activities for 150 children/teens including sessions for relaxation, mindfulness and regulation which will be held in a Safe Space within their community.	£5,000
