Request to Issue Tender for the Violence Reduction Unit (VRU) Process and Impact Evaluations

(PCC/487/2022)

Summary

The Northumbria Violence Reduction Unit is required to fund a suitably qualified provider to undertake an annual external evaluation focusing on the processes and impact of the following commissioned interventions:

CASPS

Divert - Custody Diversion

Focussed Deterrence

The Home Office has stated that a minimum of £80,000 per annum is allocated for the provision of external evaluation. It is proposed that the contact will be for three years, with the break clauses every 12 months to review activity and trends. The total contract value for the three-year period is £240,000.
