Summary

The purpose of this report is to seek approval to publish a tender for Automatic Gates Replacement and Maintenance.

There are a number of gates across the estate which are reaching the end of their design life and are suffering regular failures leading to concerns around physical security. As such the gates need to be considered for replacement. The contract will include the installation of new gates and the repair and maintenance of both new and existing gates.


Recommendation/Findings:

It is recommended that a competitive tender exercise is carried out, to put in place a three year contract with the option to extend for an additional twelve months, and an estimated contract value of £1.6m.
