Small Building Works Framework

(PCC/512/2023)

Summary

There is a programme of small building works each year to remodel and improve areas of the police estate in support of changes to operating models as well as officer and staff wellbeing. Small works are currently procured using an existing term contract for building repairs as well as a range of directly employed decorating and flooring contractors. However, this method of procurement is not efficient. Approval to Tender was therefore granted in September 2022.

That tender exercise has now been carried out. The evaluation identified the most economically advantageous bid as being from CLC Contractors Ltd.


Recommendation/Findings:
