Social Media Platform

#### **Summary**

Northumbria Police does not currently engage in calls for service via social media and the NPCC has said that the public should have the choice and confidence to engage, report and interact with their local police using the digital channels which most suit their needs.

The purpose of this report is to seek approval to enter into a contract with SocialSignIn Ltd. (trading as Orlo) for the Provision of a Social Media Platform.


#### **Recommendation/Findings:**

The recommendation is to award a four-year contract (twenty-four months with an option to extend for an additional two, twelve-month periods) to SocialSignIn Ltd, with an estimated contract value of £249,000.
