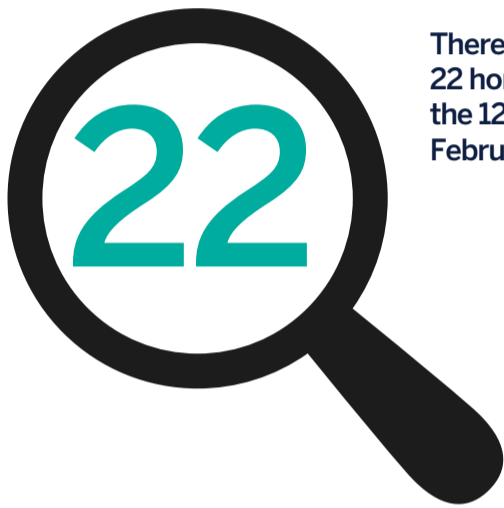


Your National Crime and Policing Measures

There have been 22 homicides in the 12 months to February 2023.

Improving victim satisfaction

Overall victim satisfaction with the police:

73%

for the 12 months to March 2023. Satisfaction has fallen 5% since the baseline year of 2019.

Satisfaction levels among domestic abuse victims:

86%

for the 12 months to March 2023. Satisfaction has fallen 2% since 2019.

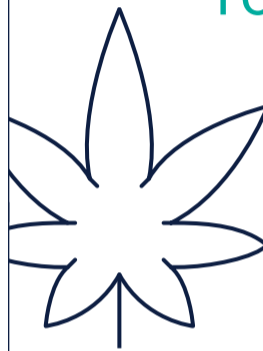
Disrupt drugs supply and county lines

Total drugs crime:

2,814

incidents for the 12 months to February 2023

Over the 12 months to February 2023, drug crime volumes in Northumbria per 100,000 population have reduced by 13% when compared against a baseline of the 12 months to June 2019.



Reduce neighbourhood crime

Burglary, robbery, theft of and from a vehicle, theft from a person: **15,855** recorded crimes for the 12 months to February 2023.



Tackling cyber crime

Confidence in the law enforcement respond to cyber-crime:

Percentage of business experiencing a cyber breach of attack:

9 for the six months to January April 2023.



This is a 10 % reduction when compared against a baseline of 6 months to December 2019.
