Title and Reference: Vehicle Conversions

(PCC/541/2023)

Summary

Due to a turnkey option not currently being available with our current Motor Patrol and ARV suppliers a contract is required to convert vehicles in line with our requirements.

Recommendation/Findings:

It is recommended that a further competition exercise is carried out utilising Lot 10 of CCS Framework 6244 (Purchase and Conversion of Emergency Service Vehicles). A 3-year contract will be agreed with the option to extend for a further 12 months. The estimated contract value for three years is £300,000. If the extension is taken up, the four-year contract is estimated at £400,000.
