Summary

To advise of the outcome from a tender exercise to let a contract for Body Armour.

Recommendation/Findings:

It is recommended to award the contract for General Purpose Body Armour to Safari Land as they provided the most economically advantageous tender.

The proposed award is for a four-year contract, with the option to extend for up to an additional three twelve-month periods, to allow for a review at the end of the initial four-year period, to ensure that this contract continues to provide the best solution for our requirements.

Contract value is £1,500,000.
