ASB Case Review – Statutory Reporting Requirement (formerly Community Trigger)

In Northumberland, Tyne and Wear, the ASB Case Review process is a regionwide partnership arrangement. All ASB Case Review activations across all of the 6 Local Authority area are received and coordinated by the Northumbria Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner who liaises with and works in partnership with Northumbria Police and the Community Safety Partnerships for each area.

The ASB Crime and Policing Act 2014 states that relevant bodies must publish the following information:

- the number of applications for the ASB Case Review received;
- the number of times the threshold for review was not met;
- the number of ASB Case Review case reviews carried out; and
- the number of ASB Case Review case reviews that resulted in recommendations being made.

Northumbria OPCC are responsible for publishing the statutory reporting information from the re-launch of the regionwide procedure in July 2022. The data presented is broken down into geographical area depending on where the ASB is taking place.

The OPCC will publish this data every 12 months.

The data from July 2022 to 31st December 2022 is available on the OPCC website.

For data prior to July 2022 please contact the respective Community Safety Partnership.

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Please Note – For ASB Case Reviews activated in latter part of 2023, the ASB Case review panels and threshold met/not met decisions may take place in 2024 and will therefore be reflected in the 2024 figures.

Similarly, where applications were made in the latter part of 2022, case decisions and panel meetings may have taken place in 2023.

These cases are referred to in the table as ‘Crossover Cases’.

We have provided a ‘Totals’ column for ease, however, the 2023 statutory reporting figures are listed in the ‘2023’ column.
