I. PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this report is to present the final revenue outturn position for 2022/23 and the transfers to/from the Commissioners revenue reserves, subject to audit.

3. BACKGROUND

3.1 The provisional revenue outturn position for the Group was presented at the Business Meeting on 8 June 2023 and reflected an underspend of £3.878m as set out below:

- 3.3 The Chief Constable's revenue budget outturn has increased by £0.108m in relation to the final accounting adjustments for Estates expenditure, mainly utilities.
- 3.4 The OPCC Supporting Services revenue outturn position shows only a small change of £0.002m against the provisional outturn reported on 8 June.
- 3.5 The outturn position for the Police and Crime Commissioner's revenue budget and Capital Financing budget are both unchanged against the provisional outturn reported on 8 June.
- 3.6 The following reflects expenditure and income in addition to the position set out in the Group revenue budget outturn table at 2.3:
 - Expenditure of £0.563m funded by the Operational Reserve.
 - Expenditure of £0.094m funded by the OPCC Innovation Reserve.
 - A net movement of £0.907m (increase) against the External Funding Reserve. This reserve absorbs timing differences between the receipt of external funding and its subsequent use inline with any terms and conditions.
 - A net movement of £0.072m (reduction) against the Northumbria share of the North-East ROCU (NEROCU) Reserve which reflects the outturn position for the year as reported at the NEROCU Management Board meeting on 16 May 2023. This position will also be reported to the NEROCU Joint Committee on 9 August 2023.
