## Summary

The purpose of this report is to seek approval to carry out a tender exercise for the delivery of the Police Entry Route Programmes.

## **Recommendation/Findings:**

The recommendation is to enter into direct negotiation with Northumbria University, via Blue Light Commercial's framework agreement.

Officers are required to continue with the Learning Provider they enrol with. To accommodate the three-year duration of the course, a six-year contract with a break at year 3 is therefore proposed, allowing year three intakes to complete their course and a new contract to be put in place for the intakes from year four onwards.
