- The right to make objections to the accounts or any item of account, of which the auditor could take action under Section 27 and 28 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014 (namely, an unlawful item of account), or could make a report in the public interest under Section 24 of that Act.
- Written notice of an objection must first be given to the auditor and a copy sent to the Chief Constable at the address set out below. No objections may be made unless the auditor has previously received written notice of the proposed objections and their grounds.
