#### Title and Reference:

Emergency Boarding and Glazing

**(PCC/579/2024)**

#### Summary

The purpose of this report is to advise on the outcome of a tender exercise to let a contract for the provision of Emergency Boarding & Glazing Services, to allow the delivery of a Priority Based Budgeting action, with the aim of reducing the Force's risk and cost related to this contract.

#### Recommendation/Findings:

Following an above threshold open tender exercise, it is my recommendation to award the contract to Boing Rapide Secure Ltd, as they provided the most economically advantageous tender.

The proposed award is for a three-year contract with the option to extend by 2 x 12 month periods.

The estimated cost for this five-year period is £325,000.

The contract value is variable and dependent on the quantity of emergency boarding services required. The estimated value is £65k per annum.
