Vehicle Conversions – Firearms and Motor Patrol

(PCC/582/2024)

Summary

The purpose of this report is to advise of the outcome from a tender process to let a contract for Vehicle Conversions Services – Firearms and Motor Patrol vehicles.

Recommendation/Findings:

It is recommended to award the tender to Coleman Milne t/a VCS as they provided the most economically advantageous tender.

The proposed award is for 36 months with a 12 month optional extension.

The anticipated annual contract value is £147,646 (pro rata over total 4 year period) based on the following fleet replacement programme;

2024/25 – 9 vehicles

2025/26 – 8 vehicles

2026/27 – 8 vehicles

2027/28 – 8 vehicles (optional year)

The anticipated total 48 month contract value (including extension options) is a maximum of £590,000.
