Summary

The purpose of this report is to seek approval to award the contract for Policy Entry Route Programmes.

Recommendation/Findings:

It is recommended that a new contract for the provision of Police Entry Route Programmes is awarded to Northumbria University via Direct Award on the new BLC Framework, "BLC0133 The National Framework for Police Constable Entry Routes".

The proposed contract is initially for a period of three years and has three optional extensions of a further twelve months.

The estimated total value of the contract, for the six-year duration, is £7,546,000.
