Airbox Mosaic Licenses

(PCC/605/2024)

Summary

Approval to award a contract to Airbox for MOSAIC licences, as part of a national agreement established by PDS.

Recommendation/Findings:

It is recommended we award a contract for a value of £564,330, via a national agreement, to benefit from negotiated discounted rates. It is anticipated Northumbria Police will save £196,830 over 4 years.

The software is already in use with the benefit and efficiencies already realised. The National agreement is lead by NPCC as there is a national drive to adopt the system in every force in the country to ensure National interoperability and to provide a tracking system for armed officers, which is mandatory.
