Title and Reference: NP0293 – Repairs and Maintenance of Alarm Systems

(PCC/659/2025)

Summary

The purpose of this report is to advise of the outcome from a tender process to let a contract for the Repairs and Maintenance of Alarm Systems across the Force.

Recommendation/Findings:

It is recommended to award the tender to ADT, as they provided the most economically advantageous tender.

The proposed award is for an initial 36-month term, with the option to extend by a further 2 x 12 months.

The submitted pricing was based on annual servicing costs of various alarms across Northumbria Police's premises, and an estimated hours of call outs for multiple different trades/requirements and an optional alarm monitoring centre. Contractors were asked to provide their hourly rates for each trade/requirement, both in and out of working hours.

The rate provided by ADT was a sum of £556,510.35, however, this is much lower than the total contract sum will be.

It is anticipated that the estimated spend will be £500,000 per annum, equating to £2,500,000 over the duration of the contract based on previous spend.
