Title and Reference: Integrated Communications Control System

(PCC/665/2025)

Summary

To seek approval to advertise an above threshold tender for a 5-year contract with x2 optional 12 month extension periods to procure a new integrated communications control system (ICCS). The budget allocated to this project is £2,600,000.

Recommendation/Findings:

Pre-market engagement has confirmed that there are several suitable solutions available in the market that better meet the Force's requirements than the existing solution which goes end of life in April 2026. All suppliers that registered an interest during pre-market engagement have confirmed their interest in the project, so an above threshold tender will promote the best competition and help achieve value for money.
