Summary

The purpose of this report is to seek approval to award a contract for the renewal of our support and maintenance for Crown.

Recommendation/Findings:

After a thorough review with the Crown project board, it is recommended a contract is awarded to Crown Computing via G-Cloud14.

The proposed award is for a 2-year contract, with the option to extend for up to two additional twelve-month periods, to allow for a review at the end of the initial 2-year period, to ensure that Crown continues to provide the best solution for our requirements.

Total contract award value is £243,550.
