Title and Reference: Repairs and Maintenance of Ventilation Systems

(PCC/674/2025)

### **Summary**

The purpose of this report is to advise of the outcome from a tender process to let a contract for the Repairs and Maintenance of Ventilation Systems across the Force.

## **Recommendation/Findings:**

It is recommended to award the tender to 21 Degrees, as they provided the most economically advantageous tender.

The proposed award is for an initial 36-month term, with the option to extend by a further 2 x 12 months.

The submitted pricing was based on annual servicing costs of ventilation systems, and an estimated hours of call outs for multiple different trades/requirements. Contractors were asked to provide their hourly rates for each trade/requirement, both in and out of working hours.

The estimated contract value is £200,000 per annum, £1,000,000 over the contract duration, based on previous spend.
