

## **Outcomes and Learning Report**

The information provided in this document provides the key learning and outcomes from the **Police Powers (PPAP)** External Advisory Panel (EAP).

Each panel consists of reviewing body worn video (BWV) footage for stop and search and use of force and a review on the performance data, with feedback provided by panel members.

*The details in this report are based on the panel meetings that took place between July 2024 to December 2024:*

### **Panel Overview**

Three panel meetings took place during this period.  
Two in person meetings to review the BWV and one virtual meeting to review the data on both stop and search and use of force.

### **Learning Outcomes**

The panel identified the following learning points for the force:

1. Increase the use of body worn video (BWV) and use it earlier.
2. To ensure that individuals stopped and searched have timely access to essential services and support.
3. Ensure individuals who are stopped and searched have access to the recordings and relevant legislation.

Panel members expressed a strong interest in understanding the impact of Section 60 searches, particularly regarding their use in predominantly black and ethnic minority communities, this is now a standard agenda item, and the panel are satisfied with the force's use of these.
