Approval to proceed with the award of a contract for technology provision to support operational policing. Contract duration is for 1 year for a total value of £665,269.19.

Recommendation/Findings:

The Home Office are funding a project for the development of technology software to support operational policing, the nature of this contract is sensitive. It is recommended a 12 month agreement is entered into on behalf of 15 UK forces, to access the ongoing development of technology services to improve operational policing. This contract is fully funded by the home office, if funding does not continue past the 12 month period, the contract will naturally come to an end.
