**Title and Reference: W031 – Accident Repairs to Police vehicles**

**(PCC/704/2025)**

**Summary**

Renewal of Accident Repairs to Police Vehicles contract for a period of 12 months at a value of £232,420.

**Recommendation/Findings:**

The accident repair contract for police vehicles is a joint collaboration agreement between Northumbria, Durham and Cleveland. It is recommended that the renewal of the original agreement awarded in 2021 is entered into for a 12 month period whilst the procurement for the new contract is undertaken, led by Cleveland Police. The incumbent supplier has agreed to honour the terms and conditions set out in the original agreement. This is the recommended route to ensure contract compliance and continuity of service.
