

Outcomes and Learning Report

The information provided in this document provides the key learning and outcomes from the **Out of Court Resolution (OOCR)** External Advisory Panel (EAP).

Each panel consists of a range of themed cases that are reviewed, with feedback provided within the meeting by each panel member.

The details in this report are based on the panel meetings that took place during January 2025 and June 2025:

Panel Overview

Two panel meetings took place during this period. The themes for these were as follows:

- Stalking, harassment and sexual offences
- Volume Crime types.

Learning Outcomes

The panel identified the following learning points for the force:

- 1. To ensure thorough communication with the local Youth Justice Service (YJS) officer prior to any community resolution being issued to enable access to a range of support services.
- 2. Due to the high number of police and other emergency service workers being victims of crimes, particularly assault, the proposed out of court offender pathway should give careful consideration to how emergency service workers can be encouraged to use the restorative justice process element of the pathway.

Overall, the panel felt there was clear consideration of victim's views and needs in the adult cases, and 73% of all cases were deemed to have been appropriate.
