Summary

The purpose of this report is to advise of the outcome from a tender process to let a contract for the Repairs and Maintenance of Building Management Systems across the Force.

Recommendation/Findings:

It is recommended to award the tender to Glenfield Energy Solutions Ltd as they provided the most advantageous tender.

The proposed award is for an initial 36-month term from the 1^{st} of April 2026, with the option to extend by a further 2 x 12 months.

The submitted pricing was based on annual servicing costs of cylon, sigma, and ecostructure systems across the Force's premises, and an estimated hours of call outs for multiple different trades/requirements. Contractors were asked to provide their hourly rates for each trade/requirement, both in and out of working hours.

The rate provided by Glenfield Energy Solutions Ltd was a sum of £298,700.00, equating to £59,740.00 per annum; however, it is anticipated that the total contract sum will be much lower than this
