

## 2025 Statutory Reporting Requirements

### ASB Case Review

The Northumbria ASB Case Review process is a regionwide partnership arrangement, where ASB Case Review activations from across all of the 6 Local Authority areas are received and coordinated by the Northumbria Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner who liaises with and works in partnership with Northumbria Police and all our Community Safety Partnerships.

The ASB, Crime and Policing Act 2014 states that relevant bodies must publish the following information:

- The number of applications received for the ASB Case Review;
- The number of times the threshold for review was not met;
- The number of ASB Case Reviews carried out; and
- The number of ASB Case Reviews that resulted in recommendations being made.

As part of the Northumbria wide ASB Case Review process Northumbria OPCC have taken responsibility for publishing the statutory reporting information every 12 months. The data presented is broken down into geographical areas depending on where the ASB is taking place.

The annual data sets from July 2022 are available on the OPCC website. For data prior to July 2022 please contact the respective Community Safety Partnership.

Please note:

- **Threshold not met** – as a region we have received 85 ASB Case Review applications and the data shows 33 of these did not meet the threshold, please note some of these may include cases where the victim has withdrawn from the process either before or after the threshold decision.
- **Cross-over cases** – these figures include those cases that have been activated in one reporting year but complete in the next.
