**Summary**

Seek approval to tender for the renewal of Microsoft Licence and Enterprise Agreement.

**Recommendation/Findings:**

It is recommended that a further competition is completed under CCS Framework RM6098 to establish a 3yr agreement for a Microsoft Licence Solution provider to supply and support our Microsoft Enterprise Agreement.

Blue Light Commercial (BLC) and the National Management Centre (NMC) have undertaken negotiations with Microsoft directly on behalf of all UK Police Forces to establish a discounted rate therefore the further competition is to appoint an approved licencing partner as Microsoft do not contract directly with customers.

Proposed total contract value is £10.5m.
