Approval to award a 36-month contract to Mi Hub Ltd t/a Yaffy following a compliant open tender process. The contract is subject to an optional 12-month extension period following the initial term dependant on supplier performance. The total contract value is approximately £405,839.50.

Recommendation/Findings:

Following an intensive operational testing exercise conducted at Pegswood Fire Station on 25th November 2025, each supplier's overall samples underwent three distinct trials to assess item specification and operational capabilities.

Following the evaluation panel's assessment and feedback from Public Order Officers involved in the testing process, the Yaffy Double-Layer variant was identified as the most suitable option. This decision was based on its superior durability, enhanced thermal protection, and overall compliance with operational requirements.

In addition to its superior performance during testing, Yaffy achieved the highest score in the quality section of the tender and offered a highly competitive price, ensuring The Force is achieving optimal Value for Money.
