To receive approval to compliantly direct award a 4.5-year contract to Motorola under the PDS Tetra Framework to provide extended warranty for the existing 4500 Motorola radios until the Airwave shutdown in 2030, for a total cost of £366,630.00

**Recommendation/Findings:**

The Motorola MXP600 radios were purchased several years ago, and the initial 3000 radios have a warranty expiration date of 30/04/2026 and the further 1500 later ordered has a warranty expiration date of 28/02/2027.

Motorola are the only supplier able to provide warranty for their products and have quoted £22.22 per radio per annum, bringing the total cost to £366,630 to extend the warranty of all radios until 2030. PDS have established a framework specifically for Tetra radio devices which includes Motorola and only allows for direct award, therefore it is recommended that this framework is utilised as a compliant route to award the contract.
