**Title and Reference: NP0156 – Legal Case Management System**

**(PCC/740/2026)**

**Summary**

To seek approval to initiate an open tender for the procurement of a modern Legal Case Management solution.

**Recommendation/Findings:**

A budget of £190,000.00 has been allocated on the basis of a 4-year contract, with 2 x 12-month extensions if utilised, for 22 users. An open tender process will provide the best form of competition and will encourage suppliers to be more competitive with their pricing, which will drive further savings based on the varying costs provided during pre-market engagement.

There is a wider opportunity to utilise the solution which ends up being procured for other case management requirements across the force.
