Notice of Pending Audit Conclusion 2024/25

In accordance with Regulation 16 (1) and (2) of the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015 the Chief Constable must state a notice when the Statutory Audit of the 2024/25 Accounts has been concluded.

The audit has now been completed and an opinion issued however a final audit conclusion is still outstanding. In line with guidance this can be issued up to 90 days after the completion of the audit. This notice is to advise readers that the Audit Conclusion and the accompanying notice will follow within the advised timeframe.

In accordance with The Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015, and the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014 local government electors are entitled to:

1. Inspect and make copies of any statement of accounts prepared by the Chief Constable pursuant to regulations under section 25 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014;
2. Require copies of any such statement or report to be delivered to them on payment of a reasonable sum for each copy.
