**Title and Reference: NP0256 Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Infrastructure**

**(PCC/753/2026)**

**Summary**

The purpose of this report is to seek approval to conduct a competitive tender exercise to appoint a supplier for the supply and installation of a new electric vehicle charging infrastructure across the Force's estate.

**Recommendation/Findings:**

It is recommended that a competitive tender exercise is conducted via the ESPO 636\_25 – Vehicle Charging Infrastructure Framework to ensure the Force achieve best value for money and to appoint the most advantageous tenderer.

The proposed award is for an initial period of 36 months, with the option to extend by 2 x 12 months if required.

The estimated contract value is £800,000.
